

GMGZ Junior Tour Added Rules for Gross Competition

9 Hole - If a Junior wins the Gross Champion trophy in a year AND have a handicap under 10, plus any junior who's handicap is under 8, then we expect that Junior to possibly be in a position to move up to the next division the following year.

6 Hole - If a Junior wins the Gross Champion trophy in a year AND have a handicap under 8, plus any junior who's handicap is under 6, then we expect that Junior to possibly be in a position to move up to the next division the following year.

3 Hole - If a Junior wins the Gross Champion trophy in a year AND have a handicap under 5, plus any junior who's handicap is under 5, then we expect that Junior to possibly be in a position to move up to the next division the following year.

If the junior competitor stays in the same competition the next calendar year and qualifies under any of the above conditions, the player will NOT be eligible to win Gross awards or set course records throughout the year. This also includes end of year Gross champion or Runner-up. The player WILL still be eligible for Nett honours throughout the year including Nett champion and Runner-up.

We do understand there may be certain circumstances where the above rules are not in the best interests of certain individuals. If the circumstances are deemed appropriate by the GMGZ Junior committee via application by the parent, this may be approved.
